

## **About The Tokyo Station Hotel**

The Tokyo Station Hotel was first established in 1915 as a European-style hotel inside Tokyo Station. It included 56 rooms and banquet space. With its stunning architecture and cutting-edge facilities for the time, it hosted a large number of visitors from around the country and the world. The hotel was closed in 2006 for around six and a half years while Tokyo Station Marunouchi Building, where it is located, was being preserved and restored. It



was completely renovated and reopened in 2012. With 150 rooms featuring a European classic theme, 10 restaurants & bars, fitness & spa facilities, banquet halls, and more, it functions as an urban hotel aiming to provide "Classic Luxury - a luxurious experience cherished across eras" with a concept of empathetic hospitality that resonates with guests. It has the distinction of being the second-oldest hotel still in operation in Tokyo and the only hotel located inside one of Japan's officially recognized Important Cultural Properties. Beside Tokyo Station, which has the greatest number of train arrivals and departures in Japan, it offers unparalleled convenience for travel not only within the Greater Tokyo Area but also to various destinations across the country, showcasing an exceptional and unparalleled location.
