



About SkyDrive Inc.

SkyDrive was established in July 2018 with the mission of “taking the lead in the once-in-a-century mobility revolution.” Since then, it has advanced the development of flying cars and cargo drones and worked in partnership with others to promote the shared vision of a future in which people use air mobility in their daily lives. SkyDrive is the only company in Japan that has successfully conducted a public piloted test flight and is now involved in designing a system for future air mobility as a member of Japan’s Public-Private Council for advanced air mobility. The company’s cargo drones, which can carry payloads of up to 30kg, are currently used at worksites in Japan, mainly in mountainous areas. SkyDrive, which aims to launch flying car service first in the Osaka Bay area in 2025, has headquarters in Toyota City, Aichi Prefecture. Tomohiro Fukuzawa is the CEO of the company. The company raised a total of 9.6 billion yen in the Series C round of financing in September 2022 and this brought its cumulative total raised to approximately 14.7 billion yen.
